	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PAPER / FIBERS</u> ✓</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Books / Brochures • Corrugated cardboard • Kraft brown paper bags • Magazines / Catalogs / Newspaper • Manila folders • Mixed paper (<i>white or color</i>) • Other (<i>envelopes, Tyvek envelopes, post-it notes</i>)
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>METALS</u> (<i>empty/clean</i>) ✓</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aerosol cans • Aluminum cans / bottles • Steel cans / bottles • Tin cans / bottles
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PLASTICS</u> (<i>empty/clean</i>) ✓</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plastics 1-2 (<i>look at the symbol/number on the item</i>) • Examples: milk jugs, water bottles, soda bottles, condiment bottles <div style="text-align: right;">  </div>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>GLASS</u> (<i>empty/clean</i>) ✓</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bottles • Jars
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>TRASH</u> ⊘</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>ANYTHING THAT IS NOT LISTED ABOVE</u> • Aluminum foil • Broken glass / ceramics • Coffee cups/lids • Food and Liquid Waste • Food, chip, and candy wrappers • Napkins, paper towels, tissue • Pizza boxes • Plastic 3 -7 • Plastic bags • Plastic straws and utensils • Polystyrene / Styrofoam • Wax-lined containers/items • Water and air filters
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>TIPS, SO IT GETS RECYCLED:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recyclables must be clean, empty, dry, and on the list of accepted materials! 2. Keep paper and cardboard separate from other recyclables. 3. When in doubt, throw it in the trash! Otherwise you risk contaminating other recyclables. 4. Universal Waste (batteries, bulbs/lamps, ink/toner cartridges, and electronics), paints and solvents must be recycled through a specialized program. <u>Do not put these in the regular recycling or trash.</u>
